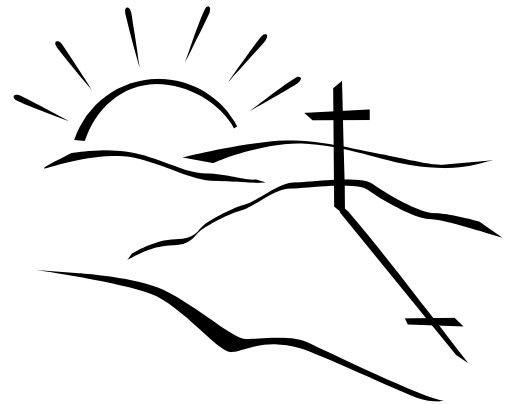
## Soup and Stations 2015 - His Sacrifice, Our Salvation

The event will begin in the Grand Worship site as we follow the sacrifice of our Lord through His crucifixion and hear a brief personal reflection, song, or prayer in relation to each station. The stations and reflections are a moving and thought provoking opportunity to acknowledge Christ’s sacrifice, and meditate on their lessons and gifts as we journey through the Lenten season.
